Beta LAYOUT GmbH hereby declares the conformity of all its PCB-POOL products in accordance with the following regulations (REACH / ROHS / POP / TSCA).

Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006 "REACH"

Since Beta LAYOUT is defined as a downstream user, it is not subject to registration. We are in close contact with our suppliers to ensure that all chemicals we use are both registered and not listed on the list of substances of very high concern. In addition, we always check the list of candidates for renewals. If any of our used substances should be listed at a future time, you can be sure to be notified.

Directive 2011/65/ EU "RoHS 2", 2015/863 / EU "RoHS 3"

RoHS is a European directive that regulates the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment in order to contribute to the protection of human health and the environment. Due to the precautionary principle, the objective of this Directive is the prevention of harmful substances in waste.

In the field of board production, this primarily concerns solder joints with leaded tin as well as halogenated flame retardants.

Regulation (EU) 2019/1021 Persistent Organic Pollutant (POP)

On 29 April 2004, Regulation (EC) No 850/2004 set detailed guidelines for the production, placing on the market, use and release of persistent organic pollutants for EU Member States. The aim of the regulation was to protect human health and the environment from POPs, in accordance with the precautionary principle. In 2019, a recast of Regulation (EU) 2019/1021 „for clarity“ entered into force.

Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA)

The Frank R. Lautenberg Chemical Safety for the 21st Century Act, passed on June 22, 2016, which empowers the US EPA to take action on certain chemicals to reduce associated risks as much as possible.

Through constant comparison with the production facilities and the international legal provisions, we can confirm legal compliance in the future until further notice.
